WHAT I AM ACCOUNTABLE FOR

- Act as a finance partner for allocated contracts within the operational business unit, delivering actionable insights and financial support.
- Lead budgeting, forecasting, and financial planning processes for allocated contracts within the operational business units. This also includes monthly reforecasting.
- Support the Finance Business Partner with the operational market budget setting processes and market wide assumptions. Prepare & finalise budget and monthly performance reports.
- Lead monthly performance meetings with operational management for allocated contract creating & discussing monthly reports with variance analysis, commentary and risks & opportunities (and escalating R&Os as they arise)
- Create pricing/financial multi-year financial models for service and regional growth highlighting key risk and opportunities and providing sensitivity analysis where required.
- Provide robust financial modelling and scenario analysis to inform strategic decisions.
- Analyse cost drivers, identify efficiencies, and support cost control initiatives.
- Collaborate with wider finance teams including analyst colleagues, Business Partners, Financial Control Teams and the Senior Finance Leadership.
- Support with the development of reports and dashboards to track performance and drive accountability.
- Ensure compliance with internal controls, accounting standards, and governance processes, maintaining relevant policies and procedures.
- Support the delivery of the finance strategic plan and continuous improvement of the team.
- Act as finance representative on wider business projects as relevant to the role.
