MY CURRENT ROLE:

SUPPORT/TRAINING:

- Full 6 month probationary period with a structured induction period, shadowing and relevant e-learning applicable to the role.

- Supervisions to support learning and development in role
- Onsite daily support from IDART Manager (external partner)

WHAT I NEED (in addition to core role profile skills and competencies):

- Caseload management experience of supporting people that have Substance Use and Domestic Abuse issues.
- Understanding of the issues, challenges and barriers this group face
- Utilise solution focussed approaches and opportunities to engage

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES I HAVE:

- To work in partnership with the IDART ensuring early identification, assessment and engagement of individuals that are or have been experiencing domestic abuse via the partnership model.
- Share key information in daily multi-agency meetings within scope of agreed ISA's, respond to risks identified and effectively implement actions to mitigate risks as part of a multi-agency response.
- Support individuals to access Inspiring Recovery's treatment interventions and where appropriate, hold a caseload of Service Users that are impacted by Domestic Abuse
- Representing Inspiring Recovery in partnership meetings and share expertise in relation to substance use knowledge and services for partners.
- Champion the needs and treatment options for this Service User group (both victims and perpetrators).
- Provide informal training with relevant partners to enable them to deliver IBA (Identification and Brief Advice) in relation to drug and alcohol use. As well as understanding of when and how to refer to specialist services.
- Specific outreach and engagement work with the IDVA car as identified from daily briefings

- Experience of working in a multi-agency environment
- Full clean driving licence and access to a vehicle
- Post is subject to Enhanced Police Vetting due to nature of the role
