SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES I HAVE:

- Working directly with young people and young adults up to the age of 25 on an individual or group basis to offer harm minimisation interventions, advice, support and treatment around substance misuse and surrounding issues
 - Recognising the professional duty of care to protect where young people or young adults present a risk to themselves or others, follow local and national legislative practice, complying with statutory requirements regarding child protection;
 - Understanding confidentiality and consent in relation to young people and young adults and ensuring duties are carried out with due regard to and compliance with the Data Protection Act and other legislation;
 - Provide training, information, advice and guidance to parents/carers and staff who work with vulnerable young people;
 - Delivering high quality person-centred interventions with the young people/young adults we support in accordance with agreed care plans and frequent key work sessions;
 - Delivering interventions at times and places to suit young people/adults
 - Work closely with external agencies, such as Children's Social Care, Adult Social Care, CAMHS, Youth Justice, Family Intervention Team, Schools, colleges and Alternative Education centres to ensure that you support young people using a multi disciplinary approach
